Why Choose BAP Certification?



Best Aquaculture Practices (BAP) is a seafood-specific certification program that addresses the four key areas of responsible seafood – environmental, social, food safety, and animal health & welfare – at each step of the aquaculture production chain such as processing plants, farms, feed mills and hatcheries.

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The BAP certification standards consist of four pillars.

1	Environmental Responsibility Addresses issues of habitat conservation, water quality, effluent, etc.
2	Animal Health & Welfare Addressing issues such as disease control.
3	Food Safety Of course, prohibited antibiotics are not used. Strict standards for other chemicals.
4	Social Responsibility Ensure the development and operation of a working environment in which the human rights and safety of producers and employees are protected.

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The Standards of BAP certification are established for the following facilities, covering the whole aquaculture supply chain.
